From the Pastor's Desk...

Dear family and friends of Grace,

Advent and Christmas are upon us! This year, however, things are not quite the same as any other year in our lifetime due to Covid-19 and all its unwanted restrictions and effects on our lives.

Mary and Joseph were no strangers to affliction and suffering either, as they made their way to the ancestral home of Joseph in order to be counted for the census. Think of how the tongues must have wagged with young Mary expecting a child before the wedding to Joseph took place. Think of poor Joseph, who knew one thing for sure - that he was not the father of the Child Mary was carrying.

It was time for Mary to deliver the child, but that didn't matter to the Roman government. The holy couple had to go to Bethlehem despite all the hardship that would be experienced on the way. As you know, when they arrived – they couldn't even find anywhere to lodge – even though it was painfully obvious that Mary was about to give birth. "No room in the inn." Can you imagine the thoughts that must have been running through their minds about then?

Ah... but here is where we need to be cautious. God Himself had sent an angel to Mary to explain to her what was going to happen when Jesus was conceived in her by the Holy Spirit. So Mary trusted. So Mary had faith. So Mary had peace.

Facilities Report:

Happy December, the month of our Savior's birth. As we prepare to celebrate this season, I wanted to give you a quick update of our facilities. We did receive some damage from Hurricane Sally and have taken steps to remedy those issues. First, we lost the roofing material on the main sanctuary building. We have secured the services of a roofing company and the material is onsite. The sanctuary roof has been covered with tarping to prevent more water leakage. We are waiting for our insurance companies adjuster to come and review all the damage. There is damage to the sanctuary ceiling, the front wall of the church and some guttering and facia on the Fellowship Hall. Once he has assessed all the damage, we will move forward with repairs. We will keep the congregation updated as we move forward.

Most of the large projects around the facility have been completed with the exception of fencing around the Youth and Yard building and the water irrigation system area. This is being requested to protect our property and staff from the homeless population that likes to reside in those areas.

The last item that was completed was the installation of locking thermostat covers in the Fellowship Hall area. This action has resulted in huge saving already. In the first full electric billing cycle since their installation, the electric bill was \$600.00 less than the previous month and a whooping \$937.00 less than the same period one year ago. This should result in tremendous savings throughout the year and help in keeping our operating cost down.

I pray everyone has a joyous Christmas season and a very safe New Year.
