Dear family and friends of Grace,

Facilities Report:

Happy New Year. Prayerfully, 2021 will be nothing like its predecessor. Hopefully, we will never experience another year like it with wildfires, flooding, a crippling virus, senseless rioting and way too many hurricanes.

As discussed at the voters meeting on December 13th, the physical condition of our church facility is better than it has been in years. The new doors in the Fellowship Hall are installed and working correctly, the other outside doors have been rebuilt and are also functioning properly. The Community Building restoration is complete and is fully usable. A new fence was installed along the north (Pen Air) side of the property, that extends behind the Community Building and joins the holding pond fence on the city park side of our property. And, two Air Conditioning units were replaced, one for the hallway classrooms and the other for the Fellowship Hall. And many smaller projects that are too numerous to mention.

Damage to the facility from Hurricane Sally was also discussed. The roofing material on the sanctuary building was blown off most of the roof. Some shingle loss/damage was also discovered on the Fellowship Hall roof along with damage to all the guttering on the east side of the hall. Sheetrock damage has been noted in the sanctuary, i.e., the ceiling peak, by one light on the ceiling, over the Praise Band are and in the music room. Repairing this damage will also lead to repainting the sanctuary walls and ceiling. There is also water damage to the flooring behind the Altar due to leaks around the stained glass window. And the flagpole in front of the church was also destroyed. We are waiting for the roofing company we have contracted with to re-roof the sanctuary and are working with our insurance company adjuster on the other damage. Repairs could cost as much as \$80,000, (our insurance deductible). We will just have to wait and see.

Other projects that we were in the process of moving forward with, (fencing around the Youth and Yard building to protect it from damage from the homeless and for staff/pre-school children, fencing the main Air Conditioning units to protect them from damage and rebuilding the irrigation pump and sprinkler system) have all been delayed due to financial constraints. We will move forward with these projects as funds become available and with approval from the BLL.
