Spiritual Gifts

In March, over 40 of us participated in a Spiritual Gifts Workshop where we each completed a Spiritual Gifts Profile. We did not collect the results of the profile so each of us could consider our own gifts and how we may use them. It has been a month and a half now and we would like to start identifying the congregation's Spiritual Gifts. Our goal is to begin developing a Spiritual Gifts profile of the congregation (Where are our strengths?) and to provide opportunities for individuals to use their gifts should they choose.

If you are willing to provide this information, we ask that you photograph the completed back of your scoring sheet with your cell phone and text it to Terena at 850 495-1355. Make sure the writing is dark enough to be read. As an alternative, you can email the information to grace@gracepensacola.org or simply bring a copy to the church office.

Why the name Stephen?

Stephen was among those chosen to provide caring ministry to those in need. Since Jesus' time, caring ministry has been a hallmark of the Christian faith community. (Acts 6)

Who are Stephen Ministers?

Stephen Ministers are members within our congregation trained to provide one-to-one Christ-centered care. They have a compassionate heart for those who are hurting and are equipped with caring ministry skills by our congregation's Stephen Leaders. A Stephen minister typically has one care receiver at a time and meets with that person once a week to listen, care, pray, encourage, and offer emotional and spiritual support.

In what types of situations do Stephen Ministers provide care?

Stephen Ministers provide care to individuals facing difficult times in life—grief, cancer, divorce, financial difficulties, hospitalization, chronic illness, job loss, disability, a spiritual crisis, or other life struggles.

What does the Stephen Ministry logo mean?

The Stephen Ministry logo represents a care receiver's journey from brokenness toward wholeness through the cross of Jesus. In this way, it illustrates "Christ caring for people through people."
