
As I said last month, I pray that you will draw closer than ever before to God during these trying days, and that He will reveal Himself to you more and more as you seek Him in His Word and prayer.

We are enrolling now for the fall of 2021. We are proud to have had the opportunity to serve the Pensacola community for 21 years. Amazing Grace serves children that are 2,3, or 4 years old. We offer a faith based half day program. We are a State licensed program through the Department of Children and Families and also a provider for the Voluntary Preschool Program.
