## From the Pastor's Desk...

Dear family and friends of Grace,

How has your life changed since March? (wow... what a question, huh?) My guess would be quite a bit in some things, not so much in others.

Between COVID-19, lockdowns, Hurricane Sally, and all that is happening politically we've had quite a year already!

However... as you look back, what are you thankful for? Stop. Think about that for more than just a quick moment. What has happened (or not happened) that you can give thanks to God for in 2020?

There really is so much to thank Him for, isn't there!

Life has changed. That's for sure. Some of you are not yet feeling comfortable to return to in person worship. That's okay. *I'm thankful* that you can participate in worship online.

Perhaps you're wondering how Grace has been affected by the things that God has allowed into our lives so far in 2020. You likely remember that from March 15 through the end of June we had no in person worship services. *I'm thankful* (aren't you?) that we remember each week that the Church is not a building, but it is the people of God – *that's you!* – and that we are still united by faith each week whether it's here in our facility, or "virtually" as we worship online through our Live Stream, or recorded via YouTube.

Let me give you a quick snapshot of some of the numbers at Grace thus far in 2020. From January  $1^{st}$  until March  $15^{th}$  our worship attendance averaged 192 people each Sunday. Since we returned to in-person worship – on July  $5^{th}$  – our average attendance has been 109 (plus those watching online).

From January 1<sup>st</sup> through March 15<sup>th</sup>, our Average Weekly Offering for the work of God's Kingdom here at Grace was \$10,702/week. Since July 5<sup>th</sup>, our Weekly Offerings have averaged \$8,562. Many, many of you have been faithful in your gifts! For that we can rejoice and give thanks to God! In fact, for the period when we were *only* online (March 22 – June 28) the average weekly offering was \$8,149! *Praise God!*

As you can see by these numbers, we are not in the same place we were before COVID. It's difficult to count attendance, due to the fact that there is virtually no way to accurately tell how many people are streaming live on Sundays, or watching online later in the week. My guess is that the actual number of people "attending" our services is *at least* what it was before COVID, if not higher. For that I'm truly *thankful!* 

That being said, it is easy to see the financial impact of COVID on our ministries. Our Offerings for the Lord's work are *down* almost *\$2,200* <u>each week</u>. Should this trend continue, we will be forced to make some significant cuts to mission and ministry here at Grace in 2021.

If you have been faithfully supporting the ministry of the Gospel at Grace – *I'm thankful!* If you've let your offerings slide off during these difficult days, won't you please consider renewing your support of the Gospel through the Ministries of Grace? And if you've never worshipped God through a thankful, prayerful response to His love and forgiveness with a financial gift to Grace, won't you please consider doing so? *I'm so thankful for your consideration!* 

There is MUCH to be thankful for! Yes, it's been quite a year already. But God has been (and always will be) faithful! *Thank Him for that!* No matter what the future may hold – we know Who holds the future!

We've resumed Sunday morning Bible Study and Children's Sunday School. We're gathering safely each week to praise and worship God and receive His gifts. Come, worship and celebrate with us!

Give thanks to the Lord, our God and King – His love endures forever!
