October 3 – Liz Richbourg Altar Flowers are given in Memory of Earl Richbourg




October 24 – Fisher Family Altar Flowers are given and Eternal Candle is lit in Honor of Chris Fisher's Birthday

# FACILITIES REPORT

The four A/C units that cool/heat the Sanctuary have been replaced and are working fantastically. They cool the sanctuary very well and are much quieter than the old units. With God's blessing, we hope to get twenty-six years of service from these units also.

As I am writing this, we are still waiting for the new guttering to be installed on the 9<sup>th</sup> Avenue side of the Fellowship Hall and some lighting replacement/repairs to be made throughout the facility. The weather is holding up the guttering installation and the lack of parts is delaying the electrical work.

As much as has been completed on the facilities the past two years, there is still much more to do. We have the sheetrock repair and painting of the Sanctuary (thanks to Sally), an irrigations well/pump and sprinkler system that needs renovating, an A/C unit dedicated to the kitchen area, adding guttering to the Sanctuary roof, exterior painting of the Youth Building (multi-purpose building), and the general upkeep of the grounds, including the holding ponds. Some of these projects we can accomplish ourselves, which is why attendance at the monthly church workdays is important. What we do ourselves, naturally saves us money, which could be used better elsewhere. The next workday will be October 16<sup>th</sup>. More information on that will be forthcoming. And thank you Bill Upton for organizing/coordinating the workdays.


